Mahala Sets Record In 440 Dash

Five men broke Flint Olympic Games records in field events Tuesday but the most significant effort at Houston Stadium was turned in by Mahala Ewell, the only girl to break a record.

Miss Ewell was supposed to be running only to qualify for Thursday's finals but cracked a six-year-old record with a time of 1:01.6 for the 440 dash in the Intermediate division.

None of the men's records was older than three years.

For the first time in the meet's 14-year history, the field events were run to completion instead of having preliminaries and finals.

Brad Colner threw the eight-pound shot put 40-10 to break a 1967 record for Junior boys and Doug Yancey tossed the 16-pound ball 50-8½ to break the open mark he set last year. Yancey is a former Southwestern High state champion who's now stationed in California with the Air Force.

Ed Fritz broke a 1967 discus record and Carl Reidsema and Greg Hoops broke high jump records.



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
