# Mott Relays Slated Friday

Northwestern High is the target for 23 rivals Friday in the third annual C. S. Mott Relays at Houston Stadium.

Northwestern, which piled up a record point total to win the city Class A championship last Friday, also is the defending champ in the Mott Relays. The Wildcats amassed 52 points to win the 1970 crown. Lansing Everett, the 1970 runner-up, also is back.

For the first time, a member of the Detroit Public School League, Cass Tech, is entered. University of Detroit High also is entered.

Others from outside the Flint area are Lansing Sexton, Pontiac Northern, Ann Arbor Huron, Ann Arbor Pioneer, East Lansing, Pontiac Central, Birmingham Brother Rice, Jackson, Clarkston and Howell.

Powers Catholic, a first-time entry, is among the Flint area contingent. Others are Central, Northern, Southwestern, Kearsley, Flushing, Grand Blanc, Clio, Beecher and Carman.

Five field events, begin at 4 p.m. and the eight-mile relay also is part of the afternoon program. Other events start at 7 p.m.

Dave Mize pitched a five-hitter as Southwestern High's baseball team earned a split with Midland, winning behind Mize, 4-2, then losing 8-4.

Jeff Natchez cracked a home run and double and drove in four runs and Tom Derwin had three hits in the doubleheader.

Southwestern's 3-1 Saginaw Valley East mark trails Midland (5-1).

Southwestern's junior varsity golf team racked up its sixth victory without a loss by downing Flushing, 211-277, at Swartz Creek. John Reed fired a 38 for the little Colts.

Roger Gerlach won the 880, 440 and pole vault and Walt Schalau took both dashes and anchored the 880 relay triumph to lead Lapeer's 89-28 victory in track against Ainsworth.
