

McKinnon on Beam

Ken McKinnon, winner of The Saginaw News sponsored inaugural Herb Korf Invitational trophy for the meet's outstanding performer, got back on the beam after a poor start in the Central Michigan Relays last week with three first place finishes to lead Saginaw High to a 76½-42½ Saginaw Valley League East Division track win Thursday.

McKinnon, who won two SVL championships in his junior season a year ago, turned in two impressive times in the hurdle events. Despite a slight aiding wind, McKinnon's efforts promise improvement over his fine showing of a year ago.

McKinnon, who's father was the first state champion under Korf for the Trojans, won the long jump high and low hurdles. He took the long jump at 20'4¾" while winning the low hurdles at 20.8 and highs with a fine time of 15.2. Those are exceptional marks for this early in the outdoor season. Plus the fact that Saginaw High's track team got a late start.

Reggie Jones, just a sophomore, had an exceptional afternoon against the Wolfpack.

Jones won the 880 run, 100 and 220-yard dashes and anchored the winning 880 relay. He turned the 880 at 2:06.5, won the 100 with a 10.0 second effort and bagged the 220 at 23.5. Darrell Drake and Cal O'Neal in the 880 relay for a mark of 1:34.6.

Arthur Hill's mile relay team of John Rolf, Brian Todd, Marty Zucker and Jim Jones took a first in the event, the final race of the afternoon, to give the Lumberjacks a victory in a tri-angular meet with Mount Pleasant and Douglas MacArthur.

The Hills' foursome turned in a 3:39.4 mile as Arthur Hill edged the Oilers, 59½-54. MacArthur was third at 34½. Jones also finished second in the high jump and set a record of 21'5½" in the long jump.
