Albatross Easy Victor In Messenger

WESTBURY, N.Y. (AP) — Albatross easily won the \$115,977 Messenger Stakes, first leg of pacing's Triple Crown, at Roosevelt Raceway Saturday night.

Driven by Stanley Dancer, Albatross passed Jake Jackson to take the lead at the end of the first quarter-mile and lead the rest of the way in winning the mile by 3 1/2 lengths over Nansumound.

It was the third straight victory for Dancer in the Messenger. He won last year with Most Happy Fellow and in 1969 with Bye Bye Sam.

After taking the lead at the first quarter, Albatross turned back challenges by Nansumound and Tarport Skipper. He turned in remarkable last half of 59 3-5, killing off all opposition with 4-5 final quarter.

Nansumound, driven by Herve Fillion, finished three-quarters of a length in front of Tarport Skipper, handled by John Champan. Jolley Roger, an entry with Albatross, finished fourth followed by Jake Jackson, Local Time, Springfield and Seton Hanover, who broke
