

Wolverine Sets AAU Track Record

Two United States girls' track marks were set at the AAU Wolverine Age Group Meet Sunday at Lincoln Park High School's Memorial Stadium.

Loretta Matejko, 13, of the Wolverine Parkettes, high jumped 5' 7" to break the old record of 5' 4½," set by Jan Dill, of California, in the 12-13-year old class.

Leslie Ross, 9, of the Oak Park Track Club, long jumped 13' 10½" to eclipse the old record of 13' 8" for the nine-and-under class set by Diane Rodriguez, of California, in 1969.

Wolverine coach, Richard Beyst, said, "Not only is Loretta's high jump a United States track record for girls —

it is also a world age group record."

The Wolverines dominated the meet by winning five first places. Competing in the meet with the Parkettes were girl athletes from the Oak Park Track Club and the Detroit Jets.

The Wolverines' medley relay team finished first in the 13-12 year old division with a

2:04.0 time.

Annette Downing placed first for the Wolverines in the 11 and 10-year old 880-yard race with a 2:45.4 clocking, while Diane Hammerle gave a high jump performance of 4' 2". They also won the 880-yard medley in 2:24.

The Parkettes also had six second place winners in the meet.
