

# Howell Sets 3 Marks, Takes 3rd In Relays

HOWELL—Howell High set three meet records to highlight the 15th annual Howell Invitational track relays at Page Field Friday.

Six records fell in all as Detroit Redford racked up 76 points to win the team title followed by Ann Arbor Pioneer with 65, Howell with 59 and North Farmington with 58.

Howell's Chip Blanchard won the mile run in 4:22.1, breaking the meet record of 4:32.3. He also busted the varsity mile record of 4:22.3 set nine years ago by Rick Zemper.

The Highlanders set

another record in the shot put relay with a two-man distance of 97 feet, 11 inches. The meet record was 96 feet, 10 inches. Steve Andersen had a toss of 50 feet, 2 inches and Jim Wheeler came through with his best effort, a heave of 47 feet, 9 inches.

Howell's sprint medley relay team of Jeff Gamble, Mark Alexander, Gary Campbell and Brian Williams set a record of 3:36.5 to break the standard of 3:38.9. Gamble ran the 440 in :52.7, Alexander and Campbell turned in 220s of :23.7 and :23.6 while Williams ran a fantastic 880 in 1:56.3.

Other meet records were set by Detroit Redford in the long jump relay, 41 feet, 10 inches; North Farmington in the shuttle hurdle relay, :57; and Darryl Strong of Ann Arbor Pioneer in the two-mile run, 9:58.6.

Howell also collected points with a third in the 880-yard relay, a fourth in the two-mile relay, a third in the mile relay, a fifth in the high jump, a third in the 100-yard dash (Steve Hagman), a third in the two-mile run (Dave Kuhlman), a fourth in the 120-yard high hurdles (Tom Kors), and a third in the

distance medley.
