

All-American Titles to Dill

LOMBARD, III.—Michigan Class A state sprint record holder Marshall Dill of Detroit Northern won both the 100 and 220-yard dashes here Saturday in the All-American H i g h School track and field championships.

Dill, who last week signed a Big Ten letter of intent to attend Michigan State, captured the century in 9.4 seconds and the 220 in 20.8. Both efforts shattered meet records.

Records were toppled in every event but one, the pole vault, taken by Roger Martin of San Jose, Calif., at 15-4½. One national prep standard fell when Randy Lightfoot of Plainview, Tex., won the high hurdles in 13.4.
