

Dill Wins 100 and 220

SACRAMENTO, Calif. — Detroit Northern's Marshall Dill established himself as the nation's top schoolboy sprinter here Saturday night when he won both the 100-yard and 220-yard dashes at the 12th annual Golden West Invitational track and field meet.

The 6-3, 195-pound Dill was named the meet's outstanding athlete. He demolished his opposition with a 21 second flat clocking in the 220 and was timed in 9.6 seconds in the century. Both races were run into a head wind of six miles an hour.

Bill, a fine football prospect, has signed a Big Ten tender at Michigan State.
