Records Fall, Tied at Charlevoix Rec Meet

CHARLEVOIX - Two new records were set and three others tied by the more than 100 boys and girls who participated in the annual summer track meets held here Thursday and Friday under the sponsorship of the City Recreation program.

The 440 yard Senior girls relay record set last year was broken by a team composed of Gayle Boss, Donna Bellow, Darlene DeWilt and Sue Fowler. They covered the distance in 83.2 seconds, breaking the old record of 84.3 seconds. The Junior boys team (Jim Alger, Dean DeWilt, Bob Russell and Todd Williams) trimmed 7 10 of a second off the old record to set a new one of 70 seconds for the same event.

Sue Fowler tied the girls' high jump record of 3'10 1/4" set last year by Chris Davenport and Lisa Bergmann; Gayle Boss tied the 25 yard dash record of 14 seconds set in 1970 by Chris Davenport and Bob Russell tied the 25 yard junior boys record of 4.35 seconds set in 1968 by Matt Doan.

In the Junior girls' division the events, winners and times follow: long jump, Linda Hufford, 8 3/4'; softball throw, Barb Allard, 78 ft.; 25 yd. dash, Carolyn Desch, 4.35; 75 yd. dash, Barb Allard, 12.75; 60 yd. hurdles, Tami Hess, 11.2; 440 yd. relay: Desch, Andrea Brown, Hess and Paige Skelton, 1:12.8.

In the senior girls division the top winners and times follow: Long jump: Donna Bellow, 12'9"; Softball throw: Cheryl Pence, 151'; high jump: Sue Fowler, 3'10 1/4"; 25 yd. dash: Gayle Boss, 4 sec.; 75 yd. dash: Gayle Boss, 10.25; 60 yd. hurdles: Sue Fowler, 9.9 and the record breaking relay team with a new time of 83.2.
