

Class C regional meet won by Dansville harriers

MASON — The Aggies of Dansville High took the Class C regional cross country meet they hosted here Saturday afternoon.

The Aggies accumulated 48 points to 70 for second place Concord. Both teams advance to the state Class C finals next Saturday in Jackson.

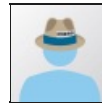
Lee Davies of Williamston was the top individual finisher with an unofficial time of 15:49. Barry Elmer of Springport, which finished fourth in team standings took sixth place honors.

With Allen Winnick's 19th-place finish leading the way, Homer's 218 team total was good for seventh. Dominic Sa-

lerno came in 31st while his St. Philip Tigers were accumulating a ninth place total of 257.

Eleventh place went to Olivet which had 326 and Dirk Rennick finishing 36th. With Craig Schonebloom coming in 44th, Bronson took eleventh with 328. Quincy's 363 was good enough for 14th. Its top runner was Roy Snyder who came in 43rd.

Since only the top two teams and the top ten qualifiers from non-qualifying schools make it to the state finals, Springport's Elmer will be the only area runner competing.
