Mike Stuparek is the kingpin of the Midland squad. He is listed in five events, four of which are first places. He leads the low and high hurdles with 19.4 and 14.7 times respectively and is third in the long jump at 21-7. He leads off the 880 and 440 relays, which Midland has the lead in.

Stuaprek is not the only outstanding performer in the area by a longshot. Saginaw High's Reggie Jones Midland Dow's Mark Poli and Carrollton's Dean Somerfield areamong the top sprinters in the state. track listing story pg 2

Jones and Poli are tied for first in the 100 at 9.9 and knotted for third in the 220 at 22.5. Somerfield leads the 220 at 22.1, is second in the low hurdles and anchors the Cavaliers' 440 relay team.

beisenhower's Kevin Tyalor is the only performer to break 10 minutes in the two mile at 9:56.0. He is also fifth in the mile at 4:40.0. Teammate Bill Singer is third in the mile and fifth in the two mile. St. Louis's Andy Kovac leads the mile at 4:32.5.



Saginaw High is second in the 880 and 440 relays, while Midland Dow is first in the mile relay and fourth in the 440.
