Jim Ryun Fades on 25th Birthday

DES MOINES, Iowa (AP)—
Comeback-trying Jim Ryun cel
ebrated his 25th birthday Saturday by fading to a next to last
place finish in an Olympic year
special mile, while the world
stance medley record and
meet marks fell steadily in the
62rd annuel Drake Related.

Kansas State, anchored by star miler Jerome Howe, smashed the existing world and national collegiate distance medley record by 1.2 seconds with a 9.318 clocking to steal the spotlight in the windup of the two-day track carrival before a capacity 18,000 at Drake Stadum.
