

# Pettyplace Wins 4 Events As Crusaders Rip Knights

SS. Peter & Paul's Area High School, led by four-event winner Dave Pettyplace, warmed up for Class B regional track competition at Caro Saturday by whipping Buena Vista, 82 1/2-42 1/2 at the Buena Vista track Thursday.

Pettyplace topped his day's work with a strong 10 3/4 locking in the 100 after winning the pole vault at 9-6. He also won the 220 and ran a leg on a winning 880-yard relay team.

Teammate George Bugenske swept the hurdle events, winning the highs in 15.5 seconds and the lows in 21.3. Sophomore Jim Young accounted for one of Buena Vista's three first-place finishes as he won the long jump at 18-10 1/2. Lamar Kimble in the 880 and Leonard Doxie in the 440 were the other Buena Vista winners.
