Despite outitting Goodrich 17-3 Friday, Genesee needed to go nine innings to post its first Suburban Conference baseball victory, 8-6, over the Martians.

Ken Foyer's Wolves enabled Goodrich to remain in the game by committing seven errors which led to five unearned runs.

Genesee scored its two runs in the ninth on successive singles by Ray Haring, Paul Selbidge, Barry Powell and Mike Holsinger. The latter two picked up the RBI.

Dave Cain led the winner's attack by stroking three singles and a two-run homer. Brad Stephens had two triples and a single and Haring and Selbidge each had two hits.

In the only other Suburban game Ortonville built an early 3-0 lead then withstood a mild Linden challenge to post a 3-2 decision.

The Black Hawks scored a pair in the first on RBI singles by Steve Felker and Dexter Hubbs. An error, single and ground out tallied the winning marker in the fourth.
