GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. OFFICIALS The Officials' Tent will be located near the center of the football field.
- 2. REGISTRATION Coaches should pick up their packet at the Concession Stand. Contestants' numbers, pins, programs, and heat and lane assignments will be issued. Coaches must make sure their contestants wear assigned numbers.
- **3. TEAMS WITH RELAYS Relay cards are enclosed in the coaches packet. It is the coaches responsibility to record name, number, and school on the relay cards, to be presented to the Clerk of Course.
 - 4. DRESSING ROOM Four dressing rooms will be available for contestants. #1 and #2 locker rooms are located under the stadium and #3 and #4 locker rooms are located in Northwestern High School. Contestants will be assigned lockers and use their own towels. Valuables should be checked with your coach or some other reliable person.
 - 5. MEALS School are responsible for their own meals. Meal tickets may be purchased for \$1.25 per person at the Concession Stand. Meals will be served in the cafeteria of Northwestern High School starting at 11:00 A.M.
 - 6. CONTESTANT SEATING AREA All contestants must sit in the designated area as shown on enclosed map. This area will be in the N.W. section of the stands.
 - 7. BULL PEN The bull pen will be located at the northwest end of the Stadium.
 All contestants should report to the Clerk of the Course in this area.
 - 8. TRAINING A physician and trainer will be available in the bull pen area.
 - 9. WARM UP The warm up area will be on the west side of the Stadium in the Driver Training Area. Contestants should be warmed up and ready to compete on the scheduled time.
 - 10. TIME SCHEDULE A time schedule has been included for your convenience.
 - 11. TRACK EVENTS All track events of 440 yards or more will be run from the center of the straightaway in front of the stands. The 100 yard dash and 120 yard high hurdles will be run on the runway across from the stands. The 220 yard dash will start on the stand side of the track with staggered starts and finish across the track from the stands. The 180 yard low hurdles will start on the scoreboard end of the track and finish across the track from the stands.
 - 12. FIELD EVENTS All field events will be held in the areas indicated on your enclosed map. The long jump may be held in one of two pits depending upon the wind direction.
 - 13. HEAT QUALIFIERS The selection of qualifiers to the Semis and Finals of the Dashes and Hurdles will be by place finishes in preliminary heats and the time for the 5th place winners as indicated on the heat sheet.

ATTENTION COACHES ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

NOTE: All finals will be run in order, and as fast as possible. There will be no delays for runners in the finals.

All contestants will remain in the stands until 1st call is made whereby they will be allowed to enter the bull pen.

All scratches should be made at the concession stand upon arrival.

Your cooperation is requested to keep contestants and spectators in their proper places as outlined below. Please discuss these items with your team:

- 1. All track shoes MUST HAVE 1/4" SPIKES OR LESS in order to run on the all-weather track. Trackmen who do not follow this rule WILL NOT be allowed to participate in the track meet.
- 2. Gill starting blocks will be available for use. No individual school starting blocks will be permitted on the track.
- 3. Contestants and coaches must stay in the northwest section of the stands as designated.
- 4. Please ask your athletes to stay away from officials at the finish line.
- 5. Each team is expected to furnish its own equipment in all field events.
- 6. Rules governing the State Meet are set forth in the 1972 Track and Field Rule Book and the Michigan State Athletic Department Bulletin of March, 1972.
- 7. Please warm up 15 minutes prior to the time indicated in the track and field events.
- 8. NO EVENT will be held up for contestants not at the starting post.
- 9. We would appreciate all coaches staying with their team and keeping them in the designated seat area.
- 10. Medals will be awarded in the center of the field at the end of each event.
- 11. There will be NO SUBSTITUTIONS for athletes qualifying from the Regional Entry Form except as allowed in the relay events.




