

Several Korf Records Should Fall Tuesday

Time, something we all could use a little more of, just keeps rolling on and everyone gets older

That isn't always a bad thing. It seems like only yesterday that the inaugural Herb Korf Invitational Saginaw County Track Meet was held, but this is the third year for the meet that honors such an outstanding track figure.

There's a bumper crop of athletes this season, and if they hold true to form a pile of records could be set.

The meet is for Tuesday at Saginaw High's scheduled track. Field events get underway at 6:30 and running events at 7:30. Rain date is Wednesday night.

A first place trophy will be awarded to each event winner. A traveling trophy will be presented to the school of the outstanding athlete of the meet.

The outstanding athlete will be named by the Korf Meet committee and Saginaw News sports staff

Mrs. Beth Korf will be on hand to witness the tribute to her late husband, who directed the Trojans to seven state championships. Former Saginaw High principal, Ward Tibbett, will be the honorary referee for the meet.

This will be the first year for a scholarship presentation to an on area track performer, who is planning attending college in the fall. The person will be named by the scholarship selection committee and will be announced at his graduation ceremonies.

The athletes have been super the past two seasons, so the biggest areas of improvement need to come in the crowd size and weather. A bit warmer temperature could bring out the crowd and add to the individual performances.

There are 16 county schools represented with over 130 athletes competing. There will be 15 events this season since the 440 relay was added this year to the prep track slate.

A good weather day could produce any number of records, since times recorded this season are better in every event except two existing Korf records.

The sprints are the most exciting to the crowd and those in attendance Tuesday will be treated to a performance by one of the state's best.

Saginaw High's Reggie Jones has gone 9.5 in the 100 and 21.7 in the 220. Both are tops for the area. He also anchors the Trojans' 880 relay team of Mike Thomas, Larry Foster and Cal O'Neal that has the best time of 1:29.7. The Trojans also have the best 440 relay mark of 44.0.

Bridgeport's Mike Arnold has the best 440 mark. He is listed at 50.7 (his best time through regional competition), but has gone 49.8. There's a tight race for 880 honors. Jim Jones of Arthur Hill and Marc Di Mercurio of MacArthur are both under two minutes.

Jones is in at 1:58.9 and Di Mercurio at 1:59.2. Dave Garcia of SS. Peter & Paul's has a 2:01.0 mark and Mike O'Rourke of Chesaning has a 2:01.4 time to his credit.

The Crusaders' George Eugenske is leader of the high hurdles at 14.8 seconds, while Carrollton's Dean Somerfield has the lows lead at 19.2.

Frank Martin of SS. Peter & Paul's has the top . mile time at 4:31.1 and Kevin Taylor of Eisenhower is the only miler two under 10 minutes at 9:56.0.

O'Neal has the top shot put mark of 56-2 in a strong field that has five 50-footers.

Saginaw High's Bob Chapman heads the long jump and high jump at 22-3 and 6-6 respectively. Jack Brechtelsbauer of Arthur Hill is the top pole vaulter at 13-0. MacArthur has the only mile relay time under 3:30.0 at 3:28.7.

The meet gives area track followers a

chance to see some of the state's top athletes and help develop a meet that will aid athletes in furthering their education. A worthwhile night for sure
