

Kearsley Is Best In Davison Relays

Kearsley High's trackmen won five of the 11 events and set a record in the pole vault Monday while piling up 65 points to win the Davison High Relays.

Grand Blanc was second with 42 points and won four events. Third-place Mt. Morris won one event and Clawson, which finished fifth, set a record for the shuttle hurdles relay.

Sophomore Jim Stokes and his senior brother, Dave, combined for a 25-9 total in the pole vault, breaking by three inches the 1969 record of another Kearsley pair.

Greg Hoops and Mike Rhoades won the high jump

and long jump for Kearsley, and Rhoades helped on the 440 relay victory.

For Grand Blanc, Tom Griggs, Dan Vallaire, Brad Jeffrey and Craig English figured in two triumphs.
