Stuparek Only Double "Leader, Others Find Strength in Numbers

Although Midland's Mike Stuparek is only individual double leader in this week's area track listings, many other top performers can be found sprinkled throughout the listing in two or more events.

Stuparek leads in both hurdle events with a 14.7 in the lows and 19.4 in the highs. He is also part of Midland's twin leadership in the 880 and 440 relays. He leads off both relays.

Arthur Hill's Jim Jones does not have a first to his credit, but he has made the top five in four events. He is second in the long jump, tied for third in the high jump, fourth in the 880 and runs the first leg of Arthur Hill's second in the mile relay.

Carrollton's Dean Somerfield has a first in the 220, second in the low hurdles and fifth in the 100. Cal O'Neal of Saginaw High is second in the shot put and runs in the 880 and 440 relays. Kelly Beltnick of Mount Pleasant has a third in the 100, fifth in the 220 and anchors the Oilers' second in the 880 relay.

Jeff Mesler of Midland has a third in the 100 and is inthe 880 and 440 relays. Mike Arnold and Bob Yare of Bridgeport have firsts in the 440 and long jump respectively while both are in the 880 and 440 relays.

There are many in two events, including George Bugenske of SS. Peter & Paul's, Chris Giering of Midland, Kim Poli of Dow, Marc Di Mercurio of MacArthur, Larry Foster and Bob Chapman of Saginaw High, Jesse Myers of Bullock Creek and Al Strieter of Unionville.

Some of the individual leaders have surpassed the leaders of last year at thispoint in the season. Stuparek has bettered both his hurdle firsts from 14.95 and 19.9 to 14.7 and 19.4. Bill Eyre has a better time in the mile as does Mike Arnold in the 440 (51.3 over 51.4), Dean Somerfield in the 220 (22.1 over 22.6), Yare in the long jump (22-1 over 21-9), Myers in the high jump by three quarters of an inch, Al Michalak in the shot put (54-10 1/2 over 54-2) and the 880 and mile relays are better than a year ago at this time.
