

Holt, Haslett Win Track Titles

MICHIGAN CENTER — Holt barely edged Mason 30½ to 30 points, for the Section 1 title of the Cardinal Track Relays here Saturday night, while Haslett captured the Section 2 crown, out-pointing Michigan Center, 36-25.

Mason won five of the events in the eight-team Section 1 scramble, with Holt taking two first places, while Haslett was victorious in five events.
