

## San Diego Girl Dominates AAU Track Championships

CANTON (Ohio) — Wind and rain didn't keep Jacqueline Thompson from her appointed runs last night in the girl's division of the Women's and Girl's AAU Track and Field championships.

Miss Thompson, running in the rain and against a three mile per hour wind, won the 100, 220 and ran legs on two winning relay teams to lead Mickey's Missiles of San Diego to the national team title with 52 points.

La Jolla Track Club was a distant second with 34 points and Detroit's Motor City Police Athletic League was third with 26.
