Comments about the Meets:

There is a limit to how many people a field house can hold and there is a limit as to how many race events can be held in a short period of time. Everything possible has been tried to hold down the numbers. All clubs must have been registered, all must have coaches in attendance (I believe this was violated), the entry fee is fairly high, the clubs are limited by event and by total numbers, the time schedule is set up to prohibit doubling, performance standards were listed on the entry blank (these were totally ignored). The indoor USATF program is going to be killed unless some coaches wise up. Possibly there will have to be qualifying outdoors or in your own meets before coming to one of the college field houses for an indoor meet. There were vaulters who couldn't clear five feet (according to the PV judge); there was a 13' long jump; a 33' shot put; and hordes of vaulters and high jumpers who couldn't come close to the starting height. There were hurdlers who couldn't 3-stop (or couldn't hurdle); there were 11:00 2milers and 6:00 milers. There were the slowest sprinters I have ever seen (along with some fast ones). There were kids and coaches in the way at the finish line and at the long jump and on the backstretch. There were kids and teens and coaches showing up late and expecting to be added. There were clubs which didn't enter and clubs which didn't pay and clubs which drove me nuts over the phone. There were clubs which hadn't practiced at all and kids who were making their initial appearance of the season. Each of these meets gets bigger and bigger. There has to be a lid someplace. No facility can possibly handle the huge mobs. It is up to the coaches to stop entering mediocre athletes. No one likes to watch endless joggers in a two mile or 10 heats in a dash. 175 sprinters or 85 long jumpers or 120 milers is ridiculous. The meet was well-run (mainly due to the efforts of Kermit Ambrose, Tony Mifsud, Bob Bloomer, Herb Badar, Bob Stallcup, Carl Krieger, Al Raynor, Kent Overboy, Jay Kolse, Don Marsh, and many, many, others too numerous to mention). It is unfair to a fine athlete like Jim Stokes of Kearsley who finally vaulted 11'5 1/2" at 11:45PM because coaches entered a bunch of lousy vaulters who had no hope of clearing 11'6". Take a good look at the complete results you have been sent & note the lousy performances in many events (along with the good ones). The complete list has been sent purposely in hopes that it will make an impression so that we can eliminate this problem next year. Actually the worst ones probably don't show up, especially in the races. In most cases the 5ths and 6ths weren't very good. Those behind them who don't show up are even worse.

On the good side, there were a number of top performances which indicates this should be a fine year for Mich. HS track this spring. Most of the athletes were well-behaved and knew what they were doing. Many of the coaches volunteered to help officiate and many entered their kids knowledgably (although many didn't). One thing is for sure, there is plenty of interest in track here in Michigan and indoor track is here, whether anyone likes it or not.
