

Baton Slip Costs Mt. Clemens Title

MANSFIELD, O. — A dropped baton, the bugaboo of all relays, cost Mt. Clemens (Mich.) High a Mansfield Relays' title here Saturday.

The Bathers were cruising at record speed when a baton exchange from its third to fourth man in the mile relay fell to the track. The 10 points Mt. Clemens lost for finishing out of the running after the bad exchange cost it the team title.

As things turned out Michael Power High of Toronto, Ontario, won the team title with 25½ points with Mt. Clemens finishing in a tie for fifth place with 20 points with Grosse Pointe North and Cleveland John Marshall.

Bob Cornwell, the sensational hurdler from Mt. Clemens, was the meet's only double winner. Cornwell won

the 180-yard low hurdles in 19.5 and the 120-yard highs in 14.1 seconds.

Michigan produced three other individual winners.

Wayne Bouvier of Washington Eisenhower won the shot put at 58 feet 6¼ inches. Reggi Jones of Saginaw captured the 220-yard dash in 20.8 seconds. Ann Arbor Huron, with a quartet of Mark Foster, Terry Brayton, Eric Larson and Don Hubbard, won the two-mile relay in 2:00.7.
