Jones, Chapman Set School Marks at Mansfield Relays

Reggie Jones and Bob Chapman combined for 18 points to give Saginaw High a seventh place finish in the Class A portion of the Mansfield, Ohio High School Track Relays Saturday.

Jones won the 220-yard dash with his best time of 20.8 seconds. That sets a school record for the event. He held the

previous mark set earlier this season.

The 20.8 effort is just two-tenths of a second off the state record. Michigan State University's Marshall Dill owns that from his prep days at Detroit Northern.

Jones also finished fourth in the 100-yard dash at 9.8 seconds. His best performance this season was 9.6. Jones won the Class A title in that event last season with a 9.8 performance and has a good chance of tying or setting a record in this year's state meet.

Chapman also set a school record with a 6-6 leap in the high jump event. That was good enough for a fourth place finish.
