

Bearcats Finally Beat Oilers

Tuesday was a day of winning streaks in local track and field competition. Midland High School added to its impressive one, while Bridgeport High School stopped another.

Midland overhauled Bay City Central, 75-48, to make it 40 in a row. The Chemics haven't lost a dual meet since 1968. Rick Smith swept both hurdle events to key the lopsided Midland victory. The Chemics are 7-0 this season.

It was another story for Bridgeport, which made it one in a row over Mount Pleasant. The Bearcats beat the Oilers for the first time ever in a dual meet.

"We really killed them," laughed Bridgeport Coach Len Callard, and then he added the punch line. "The final score was 62-61!"

Gevan Woodke broke the Bridgeport school record in the high jump with a leap of 5-feet-11½. He also took first place in the low hurdles. Mike Arnold won the pole vault and 440 events.

Kelly Beltnick claimed both sprints for the Oilers, who won the final event, the 440-yard relay, to make it a close finish.

Saginaw High's superb track team was without some of its top performers in a loss to Flint Central, 75-47, Tuesday.

Reggie Jones, the state's top sprinter, Larry Foster and Bob Chapman and Mike

Thomas are all either recuperating from injuries or still making the transition from basketball to track in conditioning.

Jones, who will enroll at the University of Tennessee next fall, didn't compete because of sore muscles. He should be ready for Friday's Mott Relays, according to coach Claude Marsh.

Another close one was the All-Saginaw Township battle between Eisenhower and Douglas MacArthur High Schools. MacArthur won it, 64½-58½. Bill Yeo starred with three firsts, in the long jump, 440 and 220. He tacked on a leg in the General's winning 880 relay effort for good measure.

There were plenty of high school baseball games on tap Tuesday, but none finished the way the Marlette-Frankenmuth game did.

Marlette came out on top, 5-4, in a game which lasted nine innings. Steve Dogelbeck scored the deciding run. He walked, stole second, was advanced to third on a wild pitch and crossed the plate when a ball got by the catcher.
