Saginaw High Sprinter Highlights Area Track

The quality of high school track has been continuously improving the past few years. This season's performers will do nothing to stop that trend.

Some exceptional times and distances were recorded by area track performers last season, and this year's crop looks like it could do even better.

The News' first area track listings of the season finds some familiar names and teams in the top five of each category from Class A, but some exceptional Class C and D performers have found their way to the

Saginaw High, behind the leadership of defending Class A state 100 and 220 dash champ Reggie Jones, has the most leaders with three. Freeland and Mount Pleasant have two each.

Midland, leading in one category, appears to have the most depth with representatives in 11 of the 15 events. Saginaw High is next with eight, followed by Arthur Hill and Bridgeport with six each and Mount Pleasant sive.

The Trojans' premier sprinter Jones, who will enroll at the University of Tennessee next fall, leads the 100 and 220 categories with phenomenal times for this early in the season.

He has been clocked at 9.6 seconds in the 100, which equals the state record owned by Michigan State's Marshall Dill. Jones went 20.8 in the 220 dash, just missing Dill's record mark of 20.6 in that event.

Jones also anchors Saginaw High's 880yard relay team, which placed fourth in the first listing of the season. Mike Thomas, Larry Foster and Robert Walker joined Jones to record a 1:34.9 mark. They're sure to improve on that as the season progresses.

The only other double winner comes from the Class C ranks in Freeland's Dennis Sova. He has emerged as the area's top hurdler. Mike Stuparek has departed from Midland, so the field is wide open this season.

Sova, who looks quite promising for high honors in 'C' this season, has recorded marks of 15.4 in the 120 highs and 20.7 in the 180 lows Sova is tied with Vassar's Larry Martin for first in the highs.

Mount Pleasant's leaders come from the shot put and 880 relay.

Doug Thielen leads the shot putters with a toss of 53-8 so far this season. Wayne Bouvier of Wayne Eisenhower has already topped the 60-feet mark so that's something for area putters to work at.

The Oilers' 880 quartet of Kip Schmidt, Kelly Beltnick, Dean Baij and Obe Nwabara lead with a time of 1:34.3. That event is close with the fourth place team, Saginaw High, just five-tenths of a second off the leading time.

Saginaw High and Midland are the only teams with representatives in each of the three relay events. Bad Axe, Mount Pleasant and Bridgeport are in two of the three categories.

The area performers are still two weeks away from regional meets in their respective classes, but already times and distances have been recorded by event leaders that are good enough to make it as additional qualifiers for regional meets.

The News will print the top times each Sunday, but will need the cooperation of all area coaches in reporting regularly and noting a top effort by an individual and relay team.
