

SH's Jones Hits 9.6 100 First Time Out

Saginaw High's Reggie Jones, the state's Class A 100 and 220-yard dash champ from a year ago, is picking up right where he left off only better.

Jones, who won the 100 with a 9.8 second

clocking and 220 at 21.6 and led the Trojans to a second place finish behind Oak Park in the state meet, ran his first race Tuesday and was clocked at 9.6. That was without the wind at his back. Jones did a 9.5 wind-aided time last season.

Jones also won the 220 at 21.9. The times themselves are quite an achievement, but this was accomplished after only two days of track workouts. Jones was a member of Saginaw High's state runner-up basketball team. He joined the track team Monday.

Flint Southwestern won the meet, 74-31, but the Trojans were competing without some of its top performers who were also on the basketball team and aren't ready for track competition yet.
