

# Trojans qualify 5 for state finals, break 2 records

Traverse City's Trojans qualified in five events for a fine showing in the state track finals Friday night at Flint on the Northwestern track, set two new school records and finished in fifth place in the team standings.

Winner of the Class A regional meet was host Flint Northwestern with a total of 51 1/6 points. Following in order were Flint Kearsley 34, Saginaw 32, Midland 28, Traverse City 19 1/6, Saginaw Arthur Hill 16 1/6, Mt. Pleasant 10 1/6, Flint Beecher 9 1/6, Bay City Handy 6, Bridgeport 7, Bay City Handy 6, Clio 6, Midland Dow 5 1/6, Bay City Central 5, Alpena 4, Saginaw Eisenhower 3, Owosso 2, with Bay City Juniors and Flushing not scoring. Hurdler Joe Tavis ran both hurdles in his best time of the year for a second place in both highs and lows. He was timed in the highs at 14.9, the lows in 21.3 flat to earn his state berth.

Stan Robbins ran two fine races in doubling the 440 and 880. He set a new school record for a second place in the half mile, covering the two laps in 1:37.5 minutes, then came back to run a 51.8 in 440, in sixth place, both times, his best of the year for his state berth.

Bob Park was second in the pole vault, on misses at that. He started jumping at 12 feet and cleared 12-3. His rival, Jim Stokes of Flint Kearsley who won this event at the Central Alpena 4, Saginaw Eisenhower 3, Owosso 2, with Bay City Juniors and Flushing not scoring. Hurdler Joe Tavis ran both hurdles in his best time of the year for a second place in both highs and lows. He was timed in the highs at 14.9, the lows in 21.3 flat to earn his state berth.


The 440 yard relay team of Park, Jon Knowles, Craig Gilmore and Len Stasinski set a new school record, with a time of 44.7, the first time they have been under 45 seconds this year. This quartet took third place to qualify for the state finals. The winning time was 44.5 seconds.

The Trojans also had a few near misses, Craig Gilmore running sixth in the 100 yard dash finals in 10.4, Reggie Jones of Saginaw winning the event in 9.6; the mile relay team of Jack Lane, Brian Christopher, Jerry Ogden and Stan Robbins was timed in 3:29.5 minutes for a sixth place finish; Brian Christopher was only two tenths of a second behind Robbins in the 440, another season high; Jack Lane tied for fifth place in the high jump, clearing the bar at 5-10; and the 880 yard relay team failed to place with a 1:34.2 time.

Long jumper Jim McGlothlin pulled a muscle in his specialty and did not finish the event.

The next big meet for the Trojans will be the LMAC fest at Muskegon Mona Shores next Wednesday afternoon and evening.
