## Girls in Regional Track Meet at Waverly

More than 300 teen-age girls, representing 22 high schools, converge on the Waverly High School track today for one of 10 MHSAA all-class girls' regional track and field meets.

The top finishers in each of 11 events qualify for competition next weekend in the state finals, which will be entered by East Lansing High School.

**ALTHOUGH ORGANIZED** prep girls' track has been around for several years now, 1973 is the first time that the girls have been given the opportunity to vie for sanctioned regional and state championships.

A great majority of the competitors at Waverly will wear the colors of Lansing area high schools.

Bath, Catholic Central, Charlotte, Dansville, East Lansing, Fowlerville, Grand Ledge, Haslett, Holt, Howell, Ionia, Lakewood, Michigan School for the Blind, Perry, Portland, Okemos, St. Johns, Williamston and Waverly all have filed team entries.

**PRELIMINARIES BEGIN** at 10 a.m., finals getting under way at 1:30 p.m.

The girls compete in basically the same events the boys do, with a few exceptions.

Field events consist of long jump shot put and high jump.

**RUNNING EVENTS** are the 100, 220 and 440 dashes, the 880 and mile runs, and the 80-yard low hurdles, 440 relay and medley relay.

### Pattengill's Boyd Sets Record

Terry Boyd, a Pattengill Junior High School ninth grader, has earned a niche for himself in the state record book.

Friday afternoon, in a meet involving all the city junior highs at Harry Hill High School, Boyd clocked 7.8 seconds in the 75-yard dash, two-tenths better than he ran last week in equalling the city record first set by Curtis Long, who's now a Sexton senior.

A QUICK check with Michigan High School Athletic Association officials revealed that the best previous reported 75-yard clocking for a ninth grader was 7.9 seconds.

Thus, Boyd becomes a state record holder.

In the team end of the action, Pattengill edged Rich and French in a triangular, 51 1/4-51-45 1/4, and Gardner took a dual meet from C. W. Otto, 67-54.
