Nemeth Scores in Dashes

CARO—Bob Nemeth placed fifth in both dashes here Saturday to help Pottersville to score 16 points in the Class D state final track meet at Caro High School.

The Vikings also got a sixth in the long jump from Hohn Clark, and sixth place in the 880 relay.

ELDEAN HUMMELL'S third place in the mile run, and finishes of fifth and eighth respectively from Dale Darling and Art Brooks in the two-mile, gave Dansville 11 points.
