Mid-Michigan's First Girls Track Champion is Holt's Jane Pearce

Mid-Michigan has its first state prep girls' track champion, and a lot of other place-winners to go with her. Jane Pearce of Holt won the short put event Saturday, in the first girls' state final meet, hosted by East Lansing High School. She threw 38.5, one-half inch better than runner-up Carolyn Dowling of Adrian.

HEIDI DOHERTY of Portland grabbed off third in the same event. Laurel Vietzke of both scored well in two events, finishing second in the long jump with a distance of 16-10 1/4, and taking fourth place in the 80 yard hurdles with a time of 11.5. Vietzke's performance was a major factor in providing Bath

with the best finish among local teams, a tie for ninth place with Kalamazoo Central and Adrian with 15 points. Holt was 14th with 11 points, East Lansing 19th with 8, Ionia 25th with 6.

LINCOLN PARK won the title, scoring 34. Walled Lake Western was second, 21 1/2. Flashing third, 28. Livonia Stevenson fourth, 23, and Ypsilanti fifth, 20.

East Lansing picked up a third place when its 440 relay team of Cathy Mueller, Betsy Leverich, Sandy Brassington and Julie Potter ran 51.5, just two-tenths behind winning Cadillac. Pat Williams of Charlotte was fourth in the mile, running

5:36.7. Mary Hall of Bath and Peggy Dyer of Grand Ledge picked off sixth and seventh places respectively in the same event.

TWO LOCAL girls scored in the 100-yard dash, Pam Moore of Ionia finishing fifth and Debbie Hughes of Powersville seventh. Moore also placed seventh in the 200, right behind Johanna Matthysens of Holt.

The meet produced two double winners, Anita Lee, Detroit Cass Tech's only entry, prevailing in both high jump and long jump, and Susan Latta of Clarkston taking the 440 and 880.
