

Kettering foursome sets mark

Kettering's state Class A 440-yard relay champions ran their specialty to a Public School League record time of 42.2 seconds yesterday during the conference semifinals on the Wayne State course.

Coach Lafayette Evans' foursome is composed of Anthony Thompson, Eddie Woods, El Don Parham and Charley Carroll. The former record of 43.5 was by Mackenzie a year ago.

In the state finals at East Lansing, the Kettering unit took the title with a 42.9 clocking that equalled the mark set by Oak Park a year ago.

Last Saturday the Kettering relay team was selected for The Detroit News' All-State team.

Harlan Huckleby of Cass was one of the most surprising performers in the track event. He won the 220 dash in 22.3 and was second to Northern's Jeff Dill in the 100. Dill was timed at 10.0 and Huckleby at 10.1.

The four field events, plus the two-mile run, will be held on the championship program tomorrow, also at Wayne State.
