

# Powers trackmen capture triangular

Steve Sugar set a school record with a pole vault of 14 feet as Powers won a triangular track meet at Hamady. Powers totaled 67 2/3 points, Saginaw Douglas MacArthur had 49 1/3 and Hamady 39. Sugar's effort also set a Hamady field record as did MacArthur's Bill Yeo in the long jump and Powers' Jerry Lindman and Kevin McColley in the 880 and mile, respectively. The winners:
