

# Waverly Wins at Marshall

MARSHALL—Show a track trophy to a Waverly Warrior, and look out—chances are excellent he'll win it.

Coach Bill Taft's win-happy Warriors captured their third relays title of the spring here

Saturday, gobbling up five first-place medals as they out-pointed runner-up Battle Creek Lakeview, 70-62, in the Marshall Relays.

WAVERLY, WHICH earlier

won the Holt and Hastings relays and finished second in its division in the Albion Relays, also set a meet record and broke two school marks Saturday.

Jack Snoor and Mark Krieger teamed in the pole vault relay for a record 25 feet, one-half-inch, and Snoor's vault of 13 feet, one-half-inch bettered his own school record.

The Warrior 440-yard relay team of Jeff Autenrieth, Pete Conway, Dan Kuchuk and Todd Halbert also knocked off a school mark with a fleet 44.6 clocking.

WHILE WAVERLY added victories in the long jump relay, the shuttle hurdles relay and the two-mile relay, Grand Ledge and Charlotte each won two events in an impressive showing of West Central Conference track power.

Grand Ledge tied with Greenville for third place with 48 points, capturing the mile relay with 3:30.8 and taking the medley in 8:18.4.

Charlotte had 33½ points for fifth, claiming the shot put relay title with three heaves totaling 133 feet, nine inches, and also winning the distance medley with a 10:57.7 time.
