

'Jr.' Dill a Star As Prep Trackster

Marshall Dill came up from Michigan State Saturday to see if his younger brother, Jeff, could do as well as he did two years ago in the Schafer Invitational track meet.

Marshall wasn't disappointed with Jeff's performance.

Jeff sped to a wind-aided 9.7 second victory in the 100-yard dash and won the 220 in 21.7 seconds for Northern High.

MARSHALL'S times were much better in 1971. The senior Dill won the 100 in 9.4 and the 220 in 21.2 but as Marshall pointed out Jeff is only a junior and probably hasn't reached his full potential as a schoolboy.

Grosse Pointe North, despite dropping the baton in the 880-yard relay, won the team title for the second straight year with Ken Delor winning the 440 in the superior time of 48.5 seconds and anchoring the winning mile relay team.
