

Flint Team Wins CMU Track Meet

MOUNT PLEASANT, Mich. (AP) — Flint Northern High School won five events Friday as it eased to first place in the 23rd annual Central Michigan University High School Invitational track meet.

Northern scored 52¼ points while runner up Flint Kearsley was second with 31. Saginaw Arthur Hill was third with 25.5.

Kearsley senior Jim Stokes set one of the two new meet records as he soared to 14 feet, 9¼ inches in the pole vault, breaking the old record of 14-8. Northern senior Steve Varner broke the old mile run record with a 4:25.3 clocking. The old record was 4:28.5, and Mount Pleasant High School's Craig Fuller also broke it by three-fourths of a second.

In addition to the mile, Northern took the 440 and 880 yard runs — both won by junior Keith Young — the high jump and the 60 yard dash.

Midland was fourth with 24 points, Midland Dow, Mount Pleasant and Pontiac Northern tied for fifth with eight, Muskegon Mona Shores was eighth with 7¼ and Pontiac Central and Saginaw each had five.
