YPSILANTI - Don Sleeman called it "our best team performance in the last two years."

Sprinter Doug Hennigar was the brightest gleam in Sleeman's eye. Hennigar tied his own school record in the 100, running 09.9 into the wind, then came back in the 220 to smash a Pioneer standard that had stood for 24 years.

Bob Fowler ran the 220 in 22.0 back in 1950 and none of the school's many competitors since had improved on that. Not until Tuesday, when Hennigar broke the tape at :21.7
