

Mason Adds Track Trophy

HOWELL—Mason added another trophy to its 1974 track showcase here Tuesday as the Bulldogs dethroned Halselt as the king of the Capitol Circuit in a league meet which saw six league records either tied or broken.

Mason captured six firsts and placed in all but two events to run upd 16 team points. Holt finished second with 50, while Haslett had 48.

BRUCE HOWE led the Mason team, taking two firsts and leading off the victorious Bulldog 880-yard relay team. Howe set a league record by running the 100 in 10.0 seconds and then ran the 220 in 22.6, a figure which also could be called a league record. The league mark was set on a straight away track, while Howe ran his on a curve.

Howe teamed with Dick Cowles, Lee Larner and Steve Young to wim the 880 in the league record time of 1:30.9.

Young set an individual record himself. After winning the regional 440 title in 49.

Mason fans wondered what Young could do for an encore. He found a way. Young ran Tommy Maier of Midland won Tuesday's feature race in the Carling Circuit of Champian (1997). However, 1997
