St. Louis' 880-yard relay team blistered the track in a time of 1:31.8 for the other meet record.

OVID ELSIE'S Ted Geiger. a triple winner on the evening, broke the school record in the high hurdles with a time of 15.2 and he was one leg of a record breaking mile relay team which ran a torrid 3:29.5 relay. Kirk Baese, Jon Coon and Mark Smith were the other members of the O-E record relay team. Geiger also raced to victory in low hur-
