

Mid-Michigan B Track Title Picked Off by Bullock Creek

ELSIE — Midland Bullock Creek rode the strength of its overall depth to victory here Tuesday night in the Mid-Michigan B Conference track meet.

The Lancers amassed 63½

points to outdistance their closest rival, Ovid-Elsie, by 12 points.

ST. LOUIS was third with 34, Swan Valley had 25, Corunna 23, Ithaca 19 and Chesaning 14.

Two meet records and three Ovid-Elsie records were shattered during the meet, which was highlighted by unusually warm weather.

Andy Kovac of St. Louis won the 880-yard run in a record-breaking time of 1:56.7. He also sped to victory in the 440-yard dash to help the Sharks to their third-place finish.

St. Louis' 880-yard relay team blistered the track in a time of 1:31.8 for the other meet record.

OVID ELSIE'S Ted Geiger, a triple winner on the evening, broke the school record in the high hurdles with a time of 15.2 and he was one leg of a record breaking mile relay team which ran a torrid 3:29.5 relay. Kirk Baese, Jon Coon and Mark Smith were the other members of the O-E record relay team. Geiger also raced to victory in low hurdles.

The Marauders' Dave Hines accounted for the other school record with a mile run of 4:39.2.

The victorious Bullock Creek team was also defending champion of the meet.
