

St. Louis Girls Win Track Meet

St. Louis' girls tracksters nudged Chesaning 58-32 in the Mid-Michigan B Girls confer-ence meet to leave the two schools tied for first place in the combined point totals from the Conference and dual meets with seven points each.

This marked the first year that the Mid-Michigan Conference has participated in girls athletics, which means that all of the first place times and distances are conference records.

THE KEY event for St.
Louis came in the long jump
when Peggy Perry, Tracy Osgood, and Laurie Kovac swept
the first three places in the event to set the pace for the entire meet.

Osgood proved to be the mainstay for St. Louis, notching top spots in the 80-yard hurdles and 220 along with running the leaf-off leg of the winning medley relay team.

Chesaning's Debbie Thiel took firsts in the shot put, 100, and lead-off on the 440 relay team. Valery Bila kicked in a second in the 100 for the runnerups besides running on the winning 440 relay squad.
