

Swanson, Duits set state track records

Swanson high jumped six feet, eight and one-half inches to break the state Class B high jump record (6-8) set by Portland's Charles Durrant in 1968. Swanson's leap was particularly pleasing to Pennfield coach Tom Tenney, since the senior star had not been jumping well recently after clearing a personal high 6-9 early in the season.

Hastings' Tom Duits widely missed his personal goal of 4:05 in the mile run, but the veteran distanceman did run a 4:13.1, the fastest mile ever run in a state meet in any class. The previous best was 4:13.2 by Detroit Eastern's Louis Scott in 1963. Duits clocked a 4:09.4 ear-lier in the season, but only times achieved in state meets

Other city and area placers were Harper Creek's Tom Shew, third in the broad jump at 22-2; Albion's Greg Ridley, fourth in the 100-yard dash at :10.2, and Charlotte's Dave
