CARO (AP) — Mendon piled up four first places and breezed to the Class D state high school track championships Saturday at Caro.

Mendon won the 120 high hurdles, the mile run, the 880 run and the two mile and finished with 60 points — 15½ more than runnerup North Muskegon. Flint Holy Rosary was third with 380 points — 154 more than runnerup North Muskegon.
