

Mendon trackmen take state title

CARO (AP) — Mendon piled up four first places and breezed to the Class D state high school track championships Saturday at Caro.

Mendon won the 120 high hurdles, the mile run, the 880 run and the two mile and finished with 60 points—15½ more than runnerup North Muskegon. Flint Holy Rosary was third with 38.

Robin Ray's time of 15.4 won the 120 high hurdles. Brad Courtney took the mile in 4:28.8, Wayne Wilds the 880 in 1:58.5 and Mark Dentler the two mile in 10:04.2.

North Muskegon set a record in the 880-relay. The quartet of Ray Swanson, Ron Steele, Jim Pancy and Don Stafford covered the distance in 1:31.6, eclipsing the old mark by one and two-tenths seconds which was held by Ann Arbor University School since 1967.
