Michigammes 3rd At Midland

MIDLAND — More than 30 teams and 300 women from several states participated in the Midland Invitational Track Meet over the weekend and the Ann Arbor based Southeastern Michigammes placed third.

The team championship was won by the Kettering Striders of Kettering, Ohio, and the Mt. Lebanon Track Club of Lebanon, Penn., was second.

Three Michigammes were particularly outstanding.

Ellen Dempsey soared 5-7 in high jump for the highest jump ever by a Michigan woman. Dempsey, who just turned 15, also leaped 17-7 for fifth in the long jump and ran a leg on the fourth-place 440-yard relay team.

Olympian Francie Kraker Goodridge ran the mile in 4:54 for the fastest time by a wo-

man in the midwest this year.

Jane Pierce put the shot 41-10½, another best ever by a Michigan woman.

Goodridge was spectacular running the anchor leg in the distance medley. By the time she got the baton she was in third place 50 yards behind the girl running second and 100 yards behind the girl running first. She passed one of her opponents and came within 25 yards of the winner. Kettering, the winner, set an American record but Coach Ken Simmons' Michigammes also expect to do that this summer.

"If all our girls stay healthy and show up we should do

well in the state championships," said Simmons. "We now have 42 girls on the Michigammes and competition is resulting in great performances.

"Perhaps the greatest performance of the meet considering age was the 5-7 high jump by Ellen Dempsey who already is of national caliber. The Junior Olympic district trials are June 29 and 30. We should have four or five girls in the 14-17 age group who should go on to the regional and perhaps to the national championships in Lincoln, Nebraska."

Twelve and 13 age group: Kim Wyche, sixth in the 440-yard dash.

Fourteen and 15 age group: Ann Marie, second in the mile.

Open competition: Pam Moore, third in the 220-yard dash and fifth in the 100; Martha Karason, fourth in the discus and fourth in the javelin; Betty Smith, sixth in the javelin; Cheryl Selas, sixth in the shot put; Liz Holt, sixth in the 440; Anne Pershke, sixth in the 800; Karin McKeechie, fifth in the mile; distance medley (Carol Stevens, Elizabeth Holt, Anne Pershke, Francie Goodridge), second; 440-yard relay (Pam Moore, Cheryl Selas, Ellen Dempsey, Elizabeth Holt), fourth.

Another weekend event for the Michigammes was the Lincoln Park Kiwanis Invitational but a number of club members did not participate.

A winner for the Michigammes was javelin-thrower Betty Smith.
