

Detroiters Strike Gold in National Junior Olympics

LINCOLN, Neb. — Linda Blakely, of Detroit, won a gold medal in the 220-yard dash and ran a leg on the winning girls 440-yard relay in the 1974 National Junior Olympics multi-sport championships which were completed here Sunday.

Miss Blakely, a 16-year-old senior at Northwestern High School, won the 220 in 24.4 seconds and ran the leadoff leg in the 440-yard relay team, which won in 46.8 seconds. Also on the relay team was Sue Latter, of Clarkston.

Huckleby Harlan, Dwight Jones and Stan Benefield, of Detroit, teamed with Jerry Hill, of Indianapolis, to take the 220-yard relay in 1:27.9.
