

# Orioles 7th In Class B Regional Run

CROCKERY HILLS—The Ludington Orioles finished seventh in a field of 21 teams at the Class B Regional cross country run this past Saturday at the Crockery Hills Country Club course near Nunica.

The team championship was won by Rockford with 68 points. Big Rapids finished second at 102. Sparta third at 129. Then came Holland Christian 142, Fremont 144, Zeeland 151, Ludington 185, Cadillac 221, Whitehall 234, Orchard View 249, Spring Lake 254, Kenosha Hills Fruitport, Cedar Springs, Holland West Ottawa, Muskegon Catholic Central, Coopersville, Reeths Puffer, Chippewa Hills Manistee and Muskegon Heights.

"It was a very strong regional" said Oriole Coach Ruben Gomez. "Rockford is very good, they won our invitational last month. I was very happy with the Orioles performance in the strong field."

## MCC Harriers 2nd In Regional

ELK RAPIDS—Mason County Central's subsection string came to an end on Saturday when they placed second in the Class C Regional cross country run at Elk Rapids. Clare won the team title with 63 points, with the Spartans coming in second at 90, followed by Benzie Central at 100 in the 21 team field.

"It was cold and windy and I think our team was down a bit after winning the conference, but we qualified for state as a team and it looks like we will be healthy by next Saturday," said Coach Steve Bishop. "It was a strong field and the times excellent considering the weather."

Owens of Gladwin set a new regional record with a fabulous 15:22 clocking. "The winning time last year was 16:36," went on Bishop.

We are looking forward to meeting Clare and Addison, the number one team in the state next Saturday, like I said, it looks like Don Buck and Ed Regina have shaken off the sick bug, the Spartans will be up for the state meet," concluded Bishop. 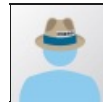
