

Three runners qualify

Three Blue Water Area cross country runners qualified for the state meet by finishing 25th or higher in the regional meet held Saturday.

Cros-Lex's Jacques Varty finished third in the regionals with a time of 15:23. Also qualifying were Port Huron Central's Steve Swarts, who finished ninth with a time of 15:46, and Anchor Bay's Neal Toward, who placed 24th in a time of 16:23.

Central finished sixth as a team. Royal Oak Shrine won the meet with 50 points. Pat Provencola, from Shrine, won the race in a time of 15:07. The three runners qualified for the state meet to be run next Saturday in Charlotte.
