Area Girls Place High In Relays

Jane Pearce and Sue Bouck have lost none of the skill that made them state girls' track and field champions in 1974. Pearce, of Holt, Class A-B girls state record-holder in shot put, won her specialty handily Friday evening, in the Spartan High School Girls Relays at Jenison Fieldhouse.

BOUCK, OF Haslett, defending Class C-D girls champion in both high jump and long jump, didn't quite win. But it took a former all-class state champion to beat her. Pearce supplied one of the meet's highlights with her winning effort of 42-9/16, a throw nearly two feet better than her state record of 41-0/16 set last spring.

Bouck cleared the same height as winner Anita Lee of Detroit Cass Tech in high jump, 5-4, but Lee was awarded the victory on the basis of fewer misses. Lee was an all-class state champion in the event two years ago.

LEE ALSO won the long jump Friday, with a leap of 17-4 1/2. Bouck was fourth in that event, right behind Fowlerville's Class C-D state 220-yard dash champion Debbie Hughes.

Lansing area girls and/or relay teams placed in every event but one.

In the two-mile run, local girls grabbed off the first, second and fourth spots. Cheryl Kerckaert of Bath charged to victory in 11:51.9, followed closely by runner-up Pat Dyer of Grand Ledge. Colleen Swain of Fowlerville was fourth.

JANET WOLLET of Fowlerville and Sue Carlson of Bath were fourth and fifth in the shot put. Carlson is de-

fending C-D state champion. Mary Sessions of Fowlerville was second, and Grand Ledge's Angela Illieff fifth, in the mile run.

In relay events, local foursomes dominated the second and third places in three of five.

Haslett and Grand Ledge tied for second behind Flint Northern in the sprint medley. Bath ran to second spot in the distance medley, won by Ann Arbor Huron, with Grand Ledge placing third. It was Holt's turn to take second in the 880 relay, also won by Flint Northern. Grand Ledge again landing in third.

BATH SCORED in the mile relay, finishing fifth.

The meet, the first of an annual series, drew 35 schools and 650 individual athletes.
