Marshall triumphs

Marshall set five school records in beating Hillsdale 55-10 and Pennfield 82-23 in a double dual Twin Valley meet at Marshall. Hillsdale outscored Pennfield 73-31. Record breakers were Kim Esbaugh in the long jump (15-8), Colleen Quada in the 220-yard dash (:28.9), Cheryl LeBlanc in the two-mile run (14:00.9), Claudia Esbaugh in the mile run (6:06.9) and the 880 relay team of Linda Passmore, Janna Heidenrich, Terri Heidrich and Colleen Quada (1:59.9).

Pennfield picked two first places, by Cheryl Hewitt in the mile run at 6:03.6 and Connie Blankenship in the 220 in :27.9.

Springfield wins

Debbie Seawater put the shot a school record 32 feet, $3\frac{3}{4}$ inches and Kathy Becke won the long jump and ran on two winning relay teams to lead Springfield to an easy 88-16 win over Galesburg-Augusta.

Colon romps

Debbie Decker and Debbie Hodgson both won two individual events and ran on the victorious 880-yard relay team as Colon ran its record to 3-0 with an 85-20 win over Constantine. Decker's winning marks were 13-11 in the long jump and :29.9 in the 220-yard dash, while Hodgson went :17.2 in the hurdles and 1:05.5 in the 440-yard dash.

Albion wins two

Albion ran its record to 3-0 with Twin Valley wins over Sturgis 64-41 and Coldwater 61-

44 in a double dual meet. The Sturgis-Coldwater score was not reported. Melanee Ridley, Karen Harris, Charmaine Mitchell and Dawn Metzler teamed to win both relays for Albion. Harris won the long jump with a leap of 14-9.

Harper runs 2nd

Harper Creek ran a solid second in a tough triangular meet at Portage Northern. Portage won on 72 points while Harper Creek had 47 and Niles 12. Sherry Bloomhuff broke two school records for Harper Creek and ran on the winning 440 relay team. She won the long jump at 15 feet, $4\frac{1}{2}$ inches, and the 100 sprint in 11.9 seconds for new records. Harper swept the first three places in the 880 run with Diane Tijerina taking the event in 2:53.9. Sue Walden was second and Mary Smith third.

St. Philip rambles

Team depth paid off as St. Philip whipped Bangor, 70-35, to win its second straight meet of an unbeaten season. Pat Guerra and Janet Chappell each won two events and ran on a winning relay. Pat took the shot put at 29-8 and hurdles in :17.4 while Janet won the 880 in 2:41.0 and the 440 in 1:08.00. Sue Wezensky won the 220 in :28.5 and ran on two relay teams for the Tigerettes. Sue Behnke took the 100 in :12.1 and ran on two winning relays and Rita Klinger captured the mile in 6:23.0 and also ran on one winning relay team for St. Philip.
