Cass runners 2nd at CMU

Detroit Cass was one of four top teams separated by only a point in Class A at the 35th annual Central Michigan University high school relays over the weekend at Mt. Pleasant.

Flint Southwestern won only one of the 12 events, but placed in six others to take its first CMU team title with 29 points Saturday. Cass, Saginaw and Midland Dow tied for second with 28 points.

Four other metropolitan area teams also were contenders. Grosse Pointe North tied for seventh with 15 points. Ann Arbor Pioneer, the defending champion, wound up 13th with eight, while Windsor (Ontario) Belle River tied for 17th with four and Detroit Western was 19th with two. The two-day CMU meet drew approximately 4,000 boy and girl athletes.

CASS HAD ONE INDIVIDUAL winner as Harlan Huckleby took the 100-yard dash in 9.7 seconds. Teammate Tom Seaborn was second in 9.9. Cass placed in five events.

Midland Dow also placed in five events and won the one-mile relay, while Saginaw placed in four and won two events, the 120-yard high hurdles and 440-yard relay.

Henry McClung, the top ranked hurdler in the state in The Detroit News' weekly listing, took the high hurdles in 13.9, only four-tenths of a second off the 13.5 record set by Bill Tipton of Pontiac Central in 1967. This was McClung's best effort for the new season, his previous best was a wind-assisted 14.1.

In Saginaw's 440 relay victory, McClung outgunned Huckleby on the anchor leg. But it was the 880 relay victory that clinched the team title for Flint Southwestern. A relay decision was worth 12 points.

River Rouge, sparked by the Myree brothers, Winston and Craig, won its seventh Class B CMU title with 52 points, but it was the first in 10 years. Rouge won three events — all relays — and placed in three others.

Rouge's foursome of Vernon Harper, Tracy DeWitt, Darwin Dayton and Craig Myree posted a one-mile relay meet record of 3:28.3. Holly trailed in 3:33.5 with Cranbrook third in 3:33.7 and Fenton fifth in 3:35.0.

THE ROUGE UNIT of Harper, Winston Myree, DeWitt and Craig Myree also won the two-mile relay in 8:15.7. William White, Eric Williams, Keith Rivers and Frank Fields won the 880 relay for Rouge in 1:31.7.

Flint Powers trailed Rouge in the point race with 36. Dwayne Strozio of Powers won the 100-yard dash in a Class B meet record time of 9.8 seconds and he was trailed by Rouge's Fields in 10.3.

Holly finished fourth with 20 points, Cranbrook and Fenton tied for 10th with 10 each, Port Huron Central tied for 16th with four and Marysville tied for 22nd with one point.

Detroit Servite was dethroned by Unionville-Sebewaing in Class C Friday, tying for 12th with six points. Unionville previously had won four Class D CMU meet titles before merging with Sebewaing and moving up to Class C.

In piling up 60 points to runner-up Wyoming Lee's 29, Unionville-Sebewaing won four events — the one-mile run, the pole vault, and the 880 and one-mile relays.

NEW HAVEN FINISHED FOURTH with 21 points and Detroit Country Day was eighth with nine. Dave Merritt of Country Day was second in the 100 in 10.4 behind 10.3 for Mark Lehman of Whitemore-Prescott. Merritt also was second in the long jump at 21 feet 6 behind 22-3 3-4 by James Henry of New Haven.

Michigan Lutheran Seminary of Saginaw won its first Class D CMU title with 54 1-6 points, trailed by defending champion Pickford with 33. Ann Arbor St. Thomas was sixth with 17 as the only metropolitan area contender.

Dale Buist of Allendale set a one-mile run meet record of 4:32.6, which was faster than the Class C time of 4:33.5 by Tim Androl of Unionville-Sebewaing.

Buist's time also equaled that of the Class B winner, Mike Stephens of Linden. In the Class A mile, Carl Stempel of Athens, Ohio, won in 4:19.3 and Jim Fisher of Grosse Pointe North finished third in 4:28.1.

Unionville-Sebewaing also won the 880 and one-mile relays with times of 1:33.6 and 3:33.6, plus the pole vault (Randy Balzer at 13 feet 6).

The best showing among the girls was by Chris Popp of Ann Arbor Pioneer with a third place finish in the high jump at 5 feet. Debbie Mullice of Ann Arbor Huron was fourth in the 100 in 12.1 seconds. Marleen Nakkala of Detroit Dominican was fifth in the high jump at 4 feet 10.

In the girls' relays, Detroit Bishop Borgess was fifth in the sprint medley with a time of 3:03.5 and New Haven was third in the 440 in 54.1 seconds.

Groves topped the 18-team field with 31 points. Pontiac Northern was second with 22, host Brother Rice was third with 21 and St. Clair Shores Lakeview and Ecorse tied for fourth with 17.

Although winning only two races — the four-mile relay and
